

## Community Star Award Terms and Conditions

1. The promoter is The Mansfield Building Society (authorised by the Prudential Regulation Authority and regulated by the Financial Conduct Authority and the Prudential Regulation Authority 206049) whose registered office is Regent House, Regent Street, Mansfield, Notts NG18 1SS.
2. Employees of The Mansfield Building Society or their family members or anyone else connected in any way with the award or helping to set up the award shall not be permitted to apply.

The award is open to existing volunteers at registered charities and community groups in Nottinghamshire or Derbyshire, excluding organisations involved in the following:

- Party political activities
- Religious causes
- Activities that benefit animals
- Commercial enterprises

All nominations must be accompanied with an explanation (between 100 and 500 words) of why the volunteer has been nominated. Any nominations received without a valid explanation by the closing date of 31 March 2020 will be excluded.

The winner will be selected from the nominations provided by a panel of judges at an assessment in April based on their interpretation of the contribution and dedication the volunteer offers. The winner will be announced at the Society's Annual General Meeting (AGM) on Tuesday 28 April 2020 at Mansfield Library.
